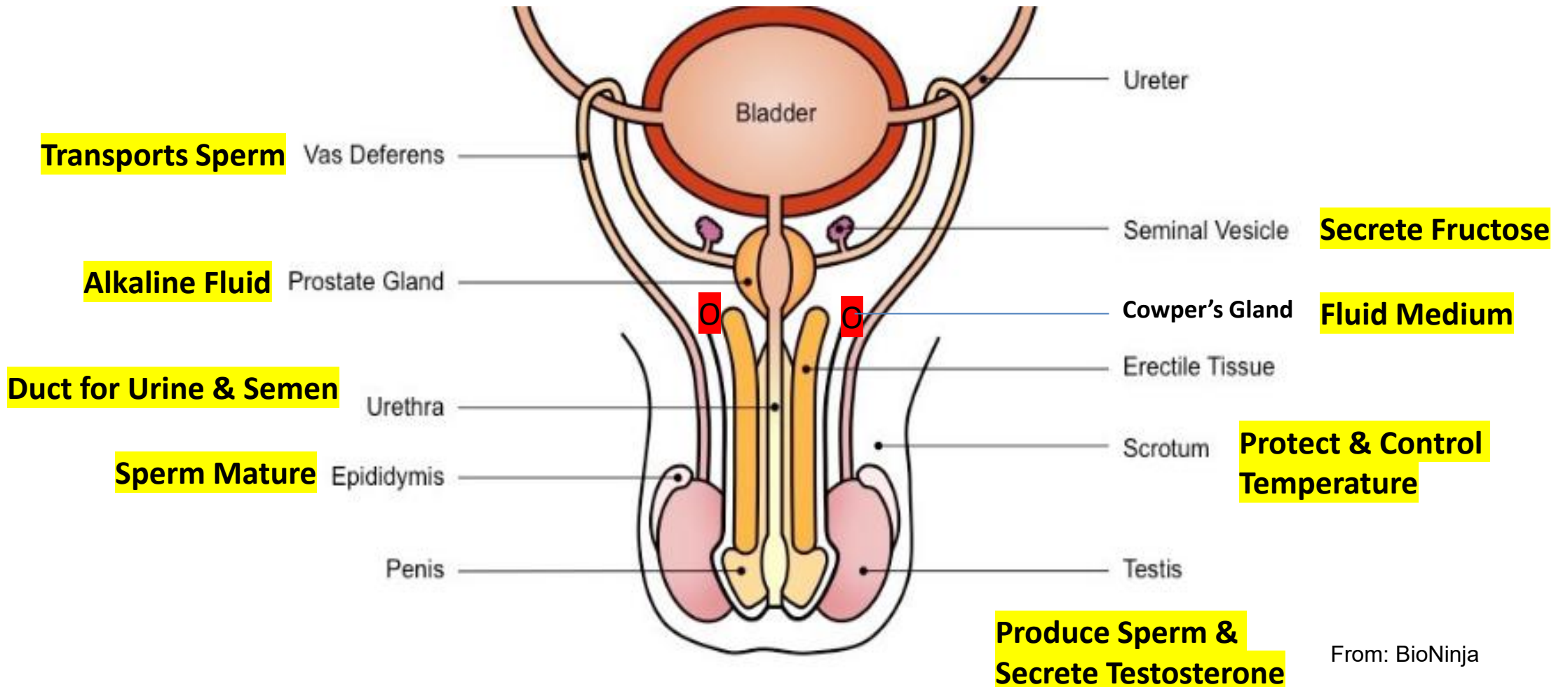

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Male Reproductive System



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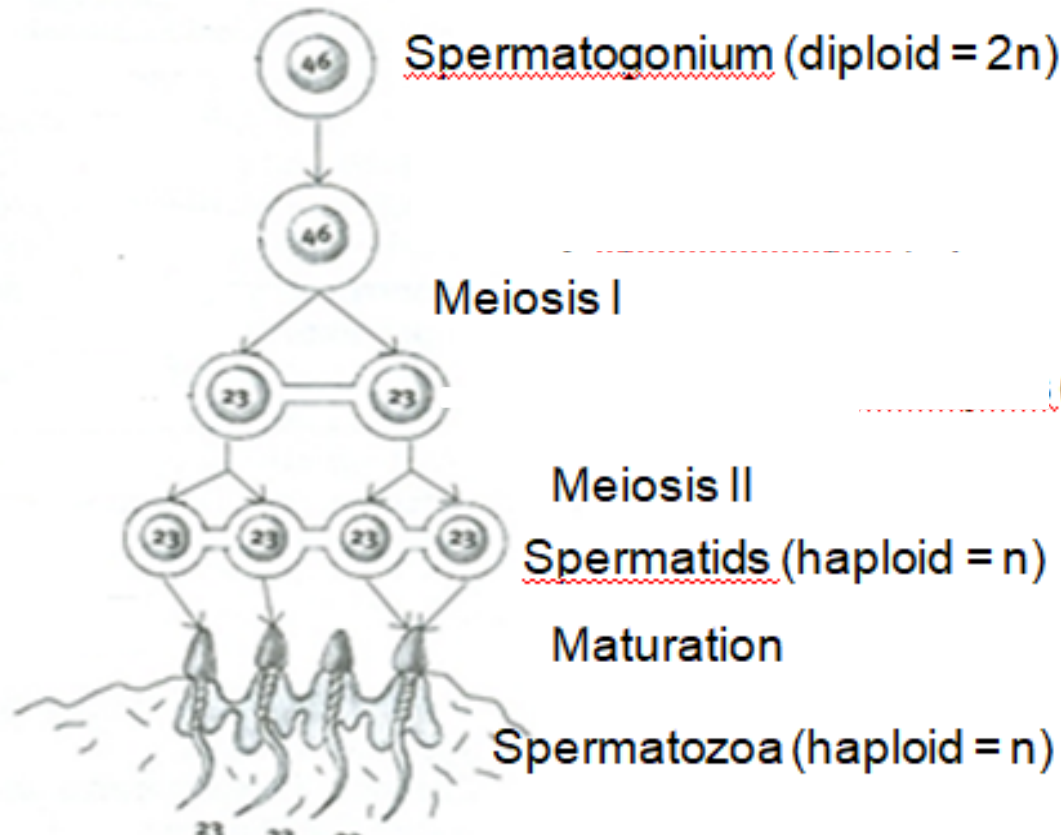
Male System – What are the Functions of ...?

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Spermatogenesis

The major function of the testes is to produce sperm in a process called spermatogenesis



1. Under Influence of Testosterone
a Continuous Process from Puberty

2. Diploid Cells in Seminiferous Tubes

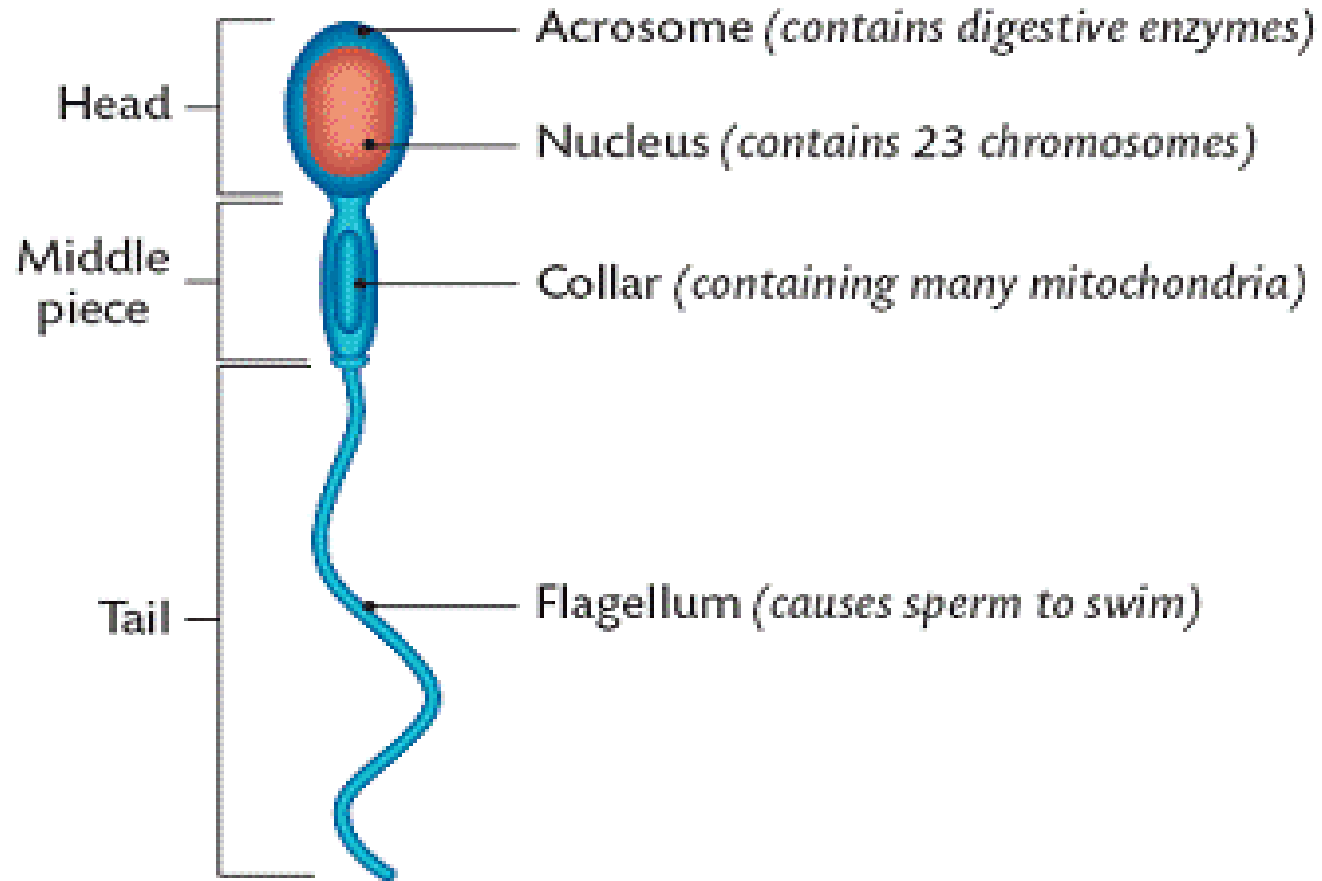
3. Undergo Meiosis

4. To Form Haploid Sperm Cells

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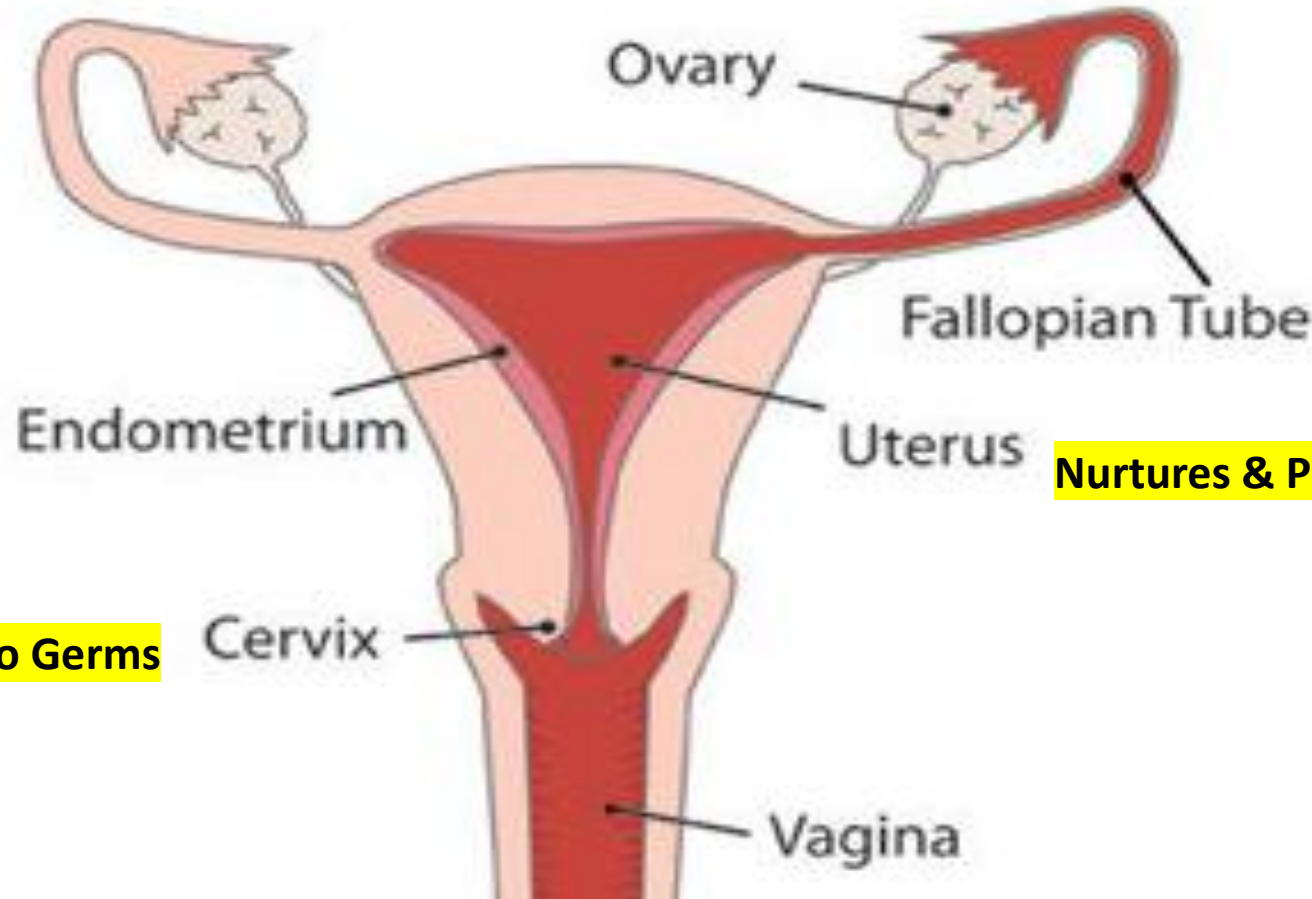
Human Sperm Cell

Barrier to Germs

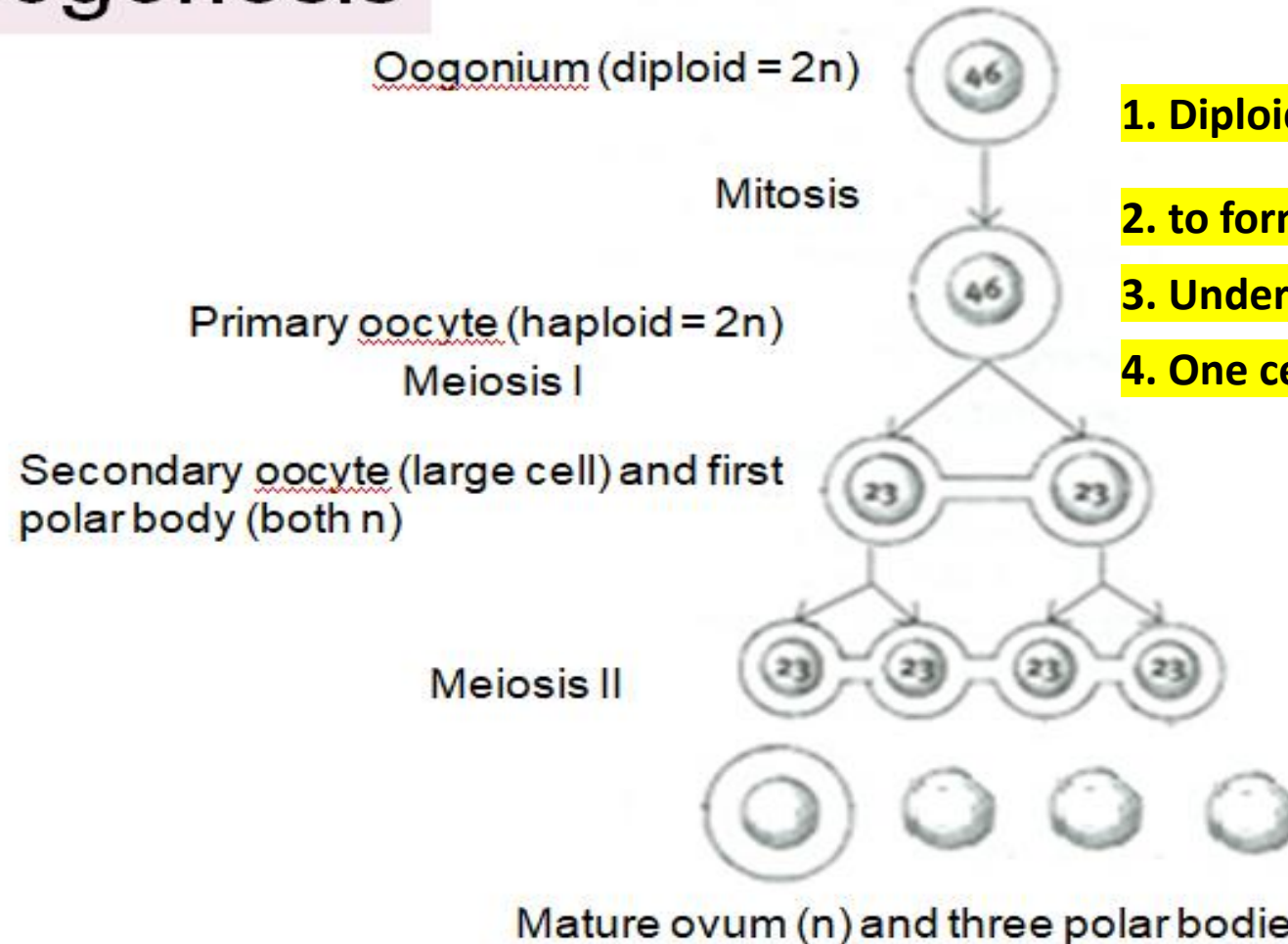

1. Diploid Cells in Ovary Undergo Mitosis

2. to form many follicles during puberty

3. Under the influence of FSH

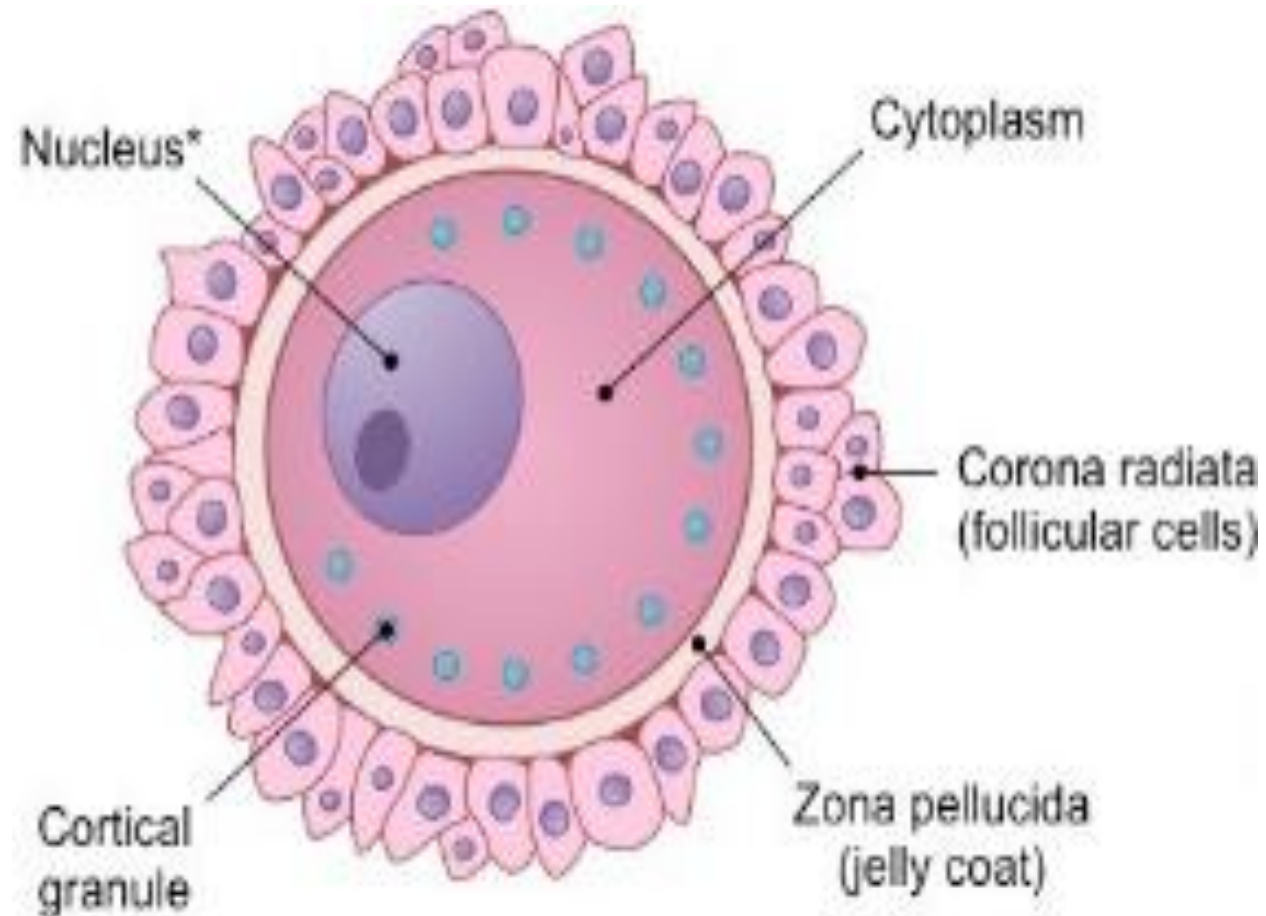
4. One cell in a follicle undergoes Meiosis

5. Of 4 cells produced, 1 becomes a mature haploid ovum

6. This occurs in a monthly cycle

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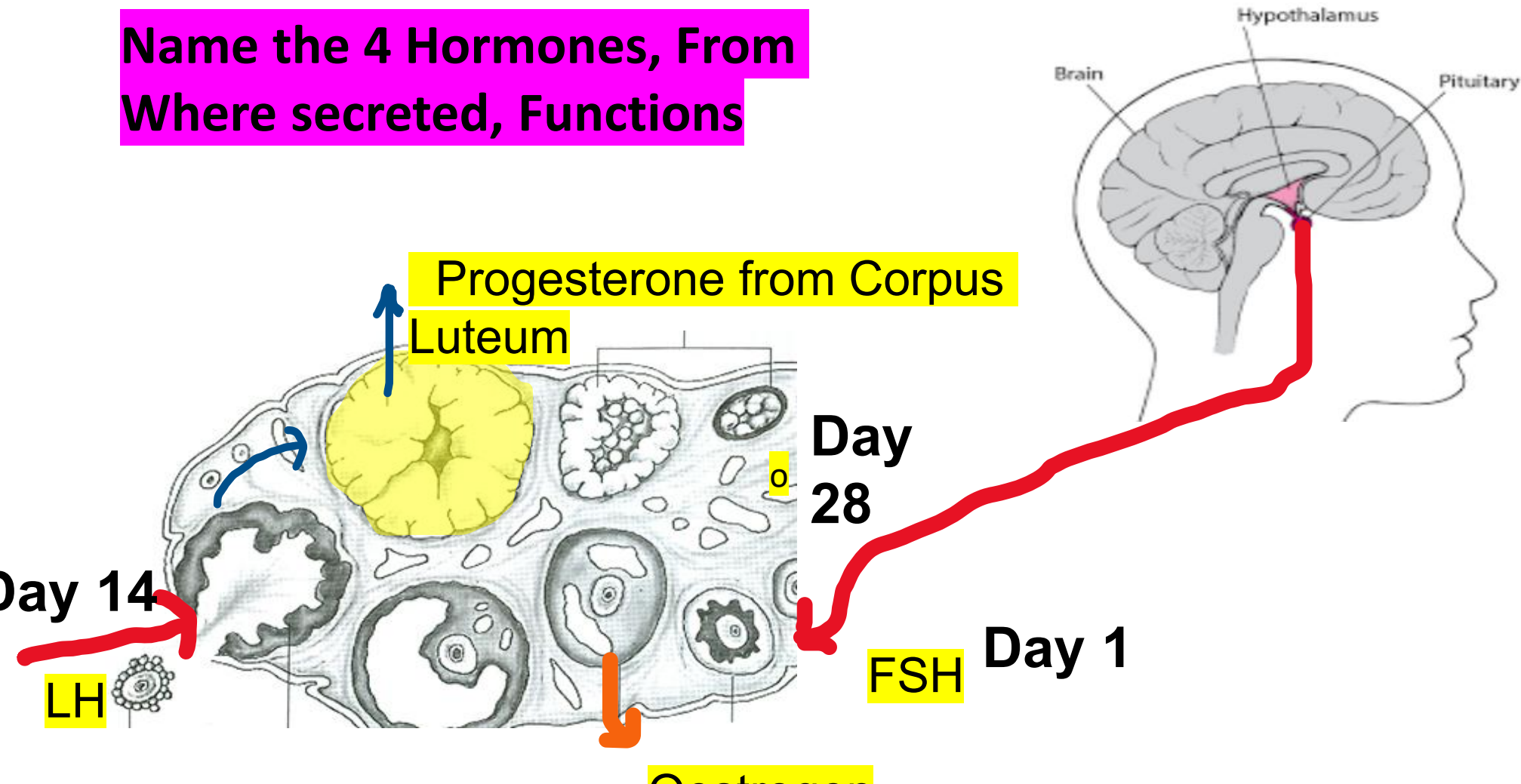
Human Ovum
